Additional Details:

- To be eligible, a person must have a physical or mental disability which results in a substantial impediment to employment, and he or she must require VR services to get a job.
- Services are individualized according to each person's rehabilitation needs and employment objective.
- Services may include counseling and guidance, training, job coaching, assistive technology, physical/mental restoration services and job placement.
